CATCH Global Foundation, its scientific partner UTHealth Houston School of Public Health, and HRIDAY, India's premier public health research organization, will collaborate to promote increased student physical activity in India through an organized, engaging, and evidence-based program.

Together, these reputable organizations have the combined expertise to also deliver the associated benefits of improved student academic performance and mental well-being, and professional development for Indian educators in order to sustain initiative efforts.

The Indian Education System is one of the largest in the world with more than 1.5 million schools, 8.5 million teachers and 250 million children.



The Need

Research has shown that students who are physically active are:

HRIDAY

- More likely to have better concentration, mood, and academic performance.
- Less likely to develop cardiovascular disease, diabetes, or cancer.
- Less likely to have symptoms of anxiety or depression.

The Solution

CATCH PE Journeys, an evidence-based physical education program complete with professional development, will be implemented by Indian educators in schools with students from low to middle socio-economic backgrounds.

- Pilot study in 10 schools in Delhi showed 136% increase in students' moderate-to-vigorous activity levels.
- Peer-reviewed by over 120 publications and dozens of white papers.
- Aligns with the Fit India Programme and the Government of India's vision to promote physical activity among young people.

Social Investment

CATCH India will partner with 1,500 schools in 10 areas and reach 225,000 schoolchildren. Services provided will include curriculum, basic equipment, and professional development. We expect to reach an average of 150 students per school, which translates to a cost of 18 USD or 1,494 INR per child who participates in CATCH India. The following phases can be accelerated based on the timing of financial commitments:
