CATCH is a nonprofit organization with the mission to empower school communities to cultivate Whole Child wellness as a lever for student success and social equity. It offers evidence-based and evidence-informed programs and professional development in various content areas (health education, physical education, vaping prevention, Social Emotional Learning, whole child wellness, etc.).

CATCH curriculum is delivered and managed via several web applications (e.g. <u>CATCH.org</u>, <u>SEL Journeys</u>). We are seeking a Technology Manager to lead the maintenance and development of these platforms using industry best practices.

In this role, you will work directly with our Director of Technology & Design to:

- Manage an offshore development team (one primary developer) and ticketing system to execute feature builds (~1/year), bug fixes, and platform maintenance
- Perform full-stack web development, testing, and deployment in conjunction with offshore team
- Review pull requests
- Create and maintain system architecture and application documentation
- Liaise with a cybersecurity firm and implement recommendations
- Oversee web file storage and data backups
- Lead strategic decisions around platform scaling, performance, and efficiency
- Assist with data reporting
- Other duties as assigned

- 5+ years experience in web or software development, plus Bachelor's degree, bootcamp certificate, and/or portfolio
- Proficiency in common coding languages and Git version control. Experience with jQuery, React, Node, Ruby on Rails, Go, and/or PHP a plus.

- Ability to oversee and coordinate complex projects
- Experience leading technical teams a plus
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to take initiative and work independently as well as part of a team
